Below are the details for our performance on April 11, 2009.

9:30am – meet at the turnstiles at the front gate of Great America.

9:45am – receive tickets and enter the gate.

10:00am – Meet in front of Celebration Plaza, just to around the carousel as you enter.  
Set up keyboard, warm-up, and sound check.

10:30 – Jazz choir performs first set

10:50 – Full choir performs second set.

11:30 – Change, if needed, and pack up. Then you will be dismissed to enjoy Great America!

AFTERNOON – you are responsible for your own ride home.

If you bring shorts to change into, you can put your jeans in a plastic bag with your name on it, and we will bring it back to the choir room for you to pick up after break. During the afternoon, take advantage of the opportunity to connect with other choir students, particularly those whom you might not know yet. If you are in a group and see another group at lunch, sit next to them and meet them. If you see another group walking in a similar direction, combine with them and enjoy conversation in the line of the next ride.
